### CLUB RULES

By applying for your child to join a club you are confirming that you have read and accepted all applicable rules.

- All sessions must be paid for in advance. Children will not be admitted to the lesson/club session at the start of term, if the school office has not received payment for the club in full. If you have any outstanding debts with the school office these must be paid up before your child can join any club.
- If parents are not in a position to pay the full amount the School may be able to provide a subsidy, Please make all requests for financial support in writing and hand to the relevant Head of each School. Please explain your circumstances at the time of making the application. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, most clubs are half price. This does not require clearance from the Head but please indicate on application slip.
- All members of a club must have completed an application form at the start of term, before sessions start. The inclusion of alternative local person to contact in an emergency is absolutely essential as the clubs are entirely independent of the school. Please ensure the school office has up-to-date emergency contact and medical notes on your child.
- Children must be collected promptly. Many providers have other lessons to attend to after the club and there is no provision for childcare once the club session is over. Please note that the school office shuts at 5.30 pm and children are not allowed to wander around the school unattended. If your child remains at school after 5.00 pm and the school staff have explored every possible contact on file trying to get your child collected, the next option will be to contact the school leadership team: in some cases social services. Children who are collected late consistently will be asked to leave the club. No refund will be given in these circumstances.
- The club coordinator/Parent Liaison Officer will do their very best to make sure that you are notified of deadlines but it remains a parent/carers responsibility to get application forms/renewal slips and money in on time and check their child's own schedule for clashes.
- Disruptive, bullying or unsociable behaviour will not be tolerated. Children who are persistently disruptive and make no attempt to change their behaviour will be asked to leave the club. No refund will be given.
- If a club is cancelled due to bad weather (except in the case where the entire school is closed due to extreme weather) the school will work with the club provider to ensure the cancelled session is replaced or that session refunded.
- Once your child has a confirmed space on a club any payment attached will be processed and no refund will be offered.
- If your child fails to attend a club having received confirmation of the space, for whatever reason, no refund will be issued for that session and or subsequent sessions they fail to attend.
- Every effort has been made to ensure your child has an enjoyable experience with a qualified provider during school clubs. If you have any concerns/queries or complaints regarding your child and their club, please contact the club coordinator in the first instance. Please do not interrupt the clubs when in session. If the club coordinator fails to address those concerns or you remain unsatisfied then please raise this in writing with either Head. If the matter still remains unresolved then the Head teachers will raise your concern/query or complaint with the board of Governors at the earliest opportunity.
